

# SGPC Village Facilities Survey 2024

**Results Analysis**

# Introduction

- ► The 2024 survey built on previous surveys & was intended to elicit an understanding of how certain village assets are used & valued, & how they could be enhanced
- It was carried out in September/October 2024
- Respondents could use a paper copy in the SGPC biannual newsletter or an online response form, the URL for which was given in the newsletter and also a link provided in the village WhatsApp chat group
- ► The survey was a mix of 9 closed & open questions relating to; Green Meadow, the Recreation Ground, Biodiversity & General suggestions
- ▶ The following slides aim to provide an analysis of the survey results
- In order to better identify trends & themes in the responses to open questions, similar responses have been grouped together



### **Green Meadow**

#### Comments & conclusions:

- 95 out of 938 households in the parish responded to the survey, representing a response rate of just over 10%
- This is understood to be at the lower end of expectations for a survey of this type
- The vast majority of respondents, over 93%, are users or former users of Green Meadow
- There would appear to be a reasonable age spread among respondents with over 42% current parents, almost 17% grandparents and over 25% past users & therefore probably parents of older children
- Not all respondents (91 out of 95) stated what they value about Green Meadow
- However, based on the number of times they were mentioned in responses, it is clear that its accessibility, play equipment, safety & its provision of green space are the principal attributes that are valued
- Its opportunities for socialising & its cleanliness/general maintenance are also notable

#### Comments & conclusions:

- Slightly fewer respondents (78 out of 95) stated what enhancements, in terms of facilities, equipment & aesthetics, they would like to see in Green Meadow
- Based on the number of times they were mentioned in responses there were no areas for enhancement favoured by a majority of respondents
- However, there is clearly a view, mentioned in over 33% of responses, that provision of equipment for older children could be improved
- The stated view of over 23% of respondents that nothing needs to be enhanced, along with both the absence of a majority view for anything specific & the lack of response from 17 respondents, perhaps suggests that the current equipment, facilities & aesthetics in Green Meadow are about right for younger children

#### Comments & conclusions

- All survey respondents completed the question asking about Recreation Ground use
- As with Green Meadow, the vast majority of respondents, over 86%, are current users
- However, slightly fewer respondents (81 out of 95)
  went on to state what they used the Rec for, perhaps
  suggesting a slightly lower level of engagement
  versus Green Meadow
- Based on the number of times mentioned in responses it is clear that walking, both with & without dogs, sport, general recreation/play & exercise are the principal reasons that respondents use the Rec

#### Comments & conclusions:

- About the same number of respondents (80 out of 95)
  went on to state what they value about the Rec as
  had responded to how they use it
- Although there are some common themes with Green Meadow, such as green space, safety & recreation opportunities, the Rec is clearly valued differently
- Overwhelmingly, respondents value its size & space, which accounts for as many mentions as the next five attributes combined
- Perhaps unsurprisingly given the nature of the Rec, sports, exercise & walking, both with & without dogs, are common themes

#### Comments & conclusions:

- Slightly fewer respondents (74 out of 95) stated what enhancements, in terms of facilities, equipment & aesthetics, they would like to see in the Rec
- Based on the number of times they were mentioned in responses there were no enhancements favoured by a majority of respondents
- However, there is clearly a theme, mentioned in over 54% of responses, that there should be provision of facilities or equipment primarily targeted at older children (MUGA, play & exercise equipment, skate park)
- This would appear to suggest that there is a desire for enhancements at the Rec to address that need

#### Comments & conclusions

- All 95 respondents answered some but not all of the initial questions about a new wildflower area
- There appears to be a consensus that there should be new wildflower areas in Green Meadow (59.8%), the Rec (73.6%) & other areas (88.6%)
- However, although only 35 respondents answered the question about 'Other' locations in table 8 opposite, somewhat confusingly 49 respondents went on to suggest specific 'Other' locations in table 8.a
- Of those there were 13 mentions for 'No more wildflower areas' & 5 for 'Green Meadow or the Recreation Ground'
- This perhaps suggests that there was some confusion amongst some respondents about what they were being asked

#### Comments & conclusions

- Only 55 out of 95 respondents provided suggestions for consideration
- Based on the number of times they were mentioned in responses there were no suggestions for enhancements favoured by a majority of respondents
- However, there were over 54% of mentions for traffic, road or footpath improvements
- Although these are outside the control of the Parish Council they are matters on which considerable time & effort is spent on lobbying & chasing
- Of the suggestions within the control of the Parish Council, some were covered elsewhere within the survey & some require further consideration



# Next steps

- Circulate the survey results analysis more widely & collate feedback
- Survey the views of Seer Green's children & young people on any enhancements to facilities & equipment
- ► Establish the feasibility of any enhancements to facilities, equipment & aesthetics
